Re: **Ontario Hockey Federation – Player Movement Policy**

Today the Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) posted a news bulletin pertaining to a new player movement policy within the OHF Membership and within their boundaries.

The province of Ontario has three separate Hockey Canada member branches (Hockey Eastern Ontario (HEO), Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF), and Hockey Northwestern Ontario (HNO)).

Hockey Eastern Ontario is not a member of the Ontario Hockey Federation, HEO operates at the same Hockey Canada Member level as the OHF and HNO. HEO, OHF, and HNO do work collaboratively on certain issues and have formulated joint policies that align with all 3 members and Hockey Canada's Bylaws & regulations, this is not one of those policies.

Decisions made solely by the OHF, and their member partners are decisions that effect their members only, and do not pertain to HEO members.

HEO members are required to continue to follow Hockey Canada Regulation C and HEO Policy 6.47 pertaining to player Residential and Registration requirements.
