## **OVERALL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- All persons (player, official or coach) registered in Hockey Eastern Ontario and in good standing are eligible;
- You must be graduating from high school in 2026 or be enrolled in a post-secondary institution for the 2026-2027 school year;
- If you are graduating from high school in 2026, you must be pursuing a career requiring further education or training (e.g. university, college, trade school etc.)
- More specific eligibility criteria can be found listed under the individual bursaries
